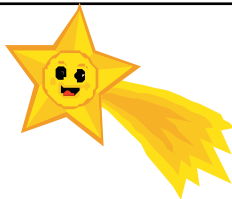


Events Term 1 2010

We have an extremely busy calendar for the rest of term with plenty of events coming up. Matariki celebrations will take centre stage with our students involved in Ki-o-rahi, Kapa Haka, Kite making, Garden creations, Drama (Maori Legends) topped off with a traditional Hangi. Please check the 'Term Dates' section in the newsletter so you are able to come along and enjoy these celebrations with us.

Reporting to parents and students is also coming up. Reports go out on the 18th of June. They will report on your child's progress and achievement against the National Standards. Teachers will be using 3 categories to explain your child's position: 'Is working below', 'Is working within' and 'Is working above'. It is extremely important that you attend 3 Way Conferences (the following week) so this is explained in more detail to you. There is also a section in the report that suggests ways you can help. This conversation with your child's teacher will make a difference to your child's achievement. We have set times for these but are able to meet with parents at other times to ensure ALL parents/ caregivers are able to attend these important meetings. You play a vital part in your child's success at school.
